Case Presentation

- 62 yo female with history only notable for Turner's syndrome admitted to the hospital with recurrent sigmoid diverticulitis (two previous episodes) with imaging showing a mesocolic abscess. Imaging also suggests a large bowel obstruction from presumed sigmoid stricture in the region of the inflammation.
- The patient has had progressive abdominal pain and distention in the setting of no productive bowel movement in 5 days. Colorectal surgery is consulted and is requesting a colonic stent for benign sigmoid stricture related to diverticular disease. Surgical planning is otherwise unclear at this time.
